Jake's Lake Rules

The following rules are intended to provide an enjoyable experience for you and your group. Parents/adults are expected to inform their children/students/scouts of these rules and are responsible for their supervision. Violation of these rules could mean early departure from the area.

REGISTRATION: All groups must register and provide all required documents prior to arrival and access to Jake's Lake.

WAIVER: All guests at Jake's Lake must have a current Release, Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement on file the Brevard County Sheriff's Office in order to participate in any activity at the Lake. If a visitor is less than eighteen years of age, the parent/guardian must provide the minor's Release Form.

CHECK-IN TIME/CHECK-OUT TIME: Groups must provide a check-in and check-out time so that a BCSO representative can be present to open and close the gate AND inspect the property.

CAMPING EQUIPMENT: Tents may be set up at any location from the large pavilion to the boathouse that does not impede emergency vehicle travel throughout the property.

GUESTS: Facilities in this park are for use by registered guests only. Any non-registered guests will be escorted off the property immediately.

SPEED LIMIT: To ensure safety at the camp, do not exceed 5 MPH.

PARKING: Registered guests should park on the sides of Ranch Road as to not hinder the safety of the guests nor impede emergency vehicle travel throughout the property. A vehicle with trailer may drive into the camp area to unload/load equipment only. There should be no parking of any vehicles inside the gate/camp area.

QUIET HOURS: 10:00PM – 8:00AM. All campers should return to their site by 10:00PM, and daily visitors/guests are required to leave at this time. Please be courteous to other campers and refrain from loud noises and disturbances during this time period.

PETS: Pets are not permitted at Jakes' Lake unless they are approved service animals.

CAMPFIRES: All fires must be contained inside the fire pit located on the property. The campfire must be kept knee-high or below and not left unattended. The fire pit is not to be used to dispose of cans, bottles or other household trash.

Jake's Lake Rules

FIREWOOD/TREES: No cutting of trees/firewood is allowed in the campground or adjoining properties. All firewood brought into the park must be removed prior to checkout or left to donate to the next set of campers. Please do not drive nails into or disfigure trees. Additionally, please do not tie clotheslines to trees or shrubs.

LAKE: WARNING!! There is NO SWIMMING PERMITTED IN THE LAKE! Alligators are present in the lake.

ALLIGATORS: **DO NOT FEED THE ALLIGATORS**!! ANY VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED.

BOATING: No boats are permitted to be brought into the park. Canoes are available if approved by Sheriff's Office staff for your convenience and pleasure. An adult must accompany children under the age of 12. Life jackets are available in the boat house AND required to be used. Please return to the boat house after use.

GARBAGE: Please instruct all campers to use the garbage cans provided on site. Only household generated garbage should be placed in these cans. <u>All</u> garbage should be collected at the end of your stay and taken with you for disposal. This is our home and we take pride in the cleanliness of our park. Please do not litter!

BATHROOMS: To avoid accidents and injuries, an adult should accompany children under the age of ten years old to the bathroom. Only toilet paper should be flushed down the toilets. Do not flush paper towels or sanitary products of any kind. Make sure all faucets are turned off when leaving. We ask that you keep an eye on the facilities and assist in maintaining them.

FACILITIES: Do not move any tables or equipment unless approved by Sheriff's Office staff.

ALCOHOL: Alcohol is NOT permitted during your stay.

SECURITY: A Brevard County Sheriff's Office Deputy resides on the property and will reserve the right to inspect the grounds at any time during your stay. If any rules are violated, your group will be asked to leave immediately.
